ADDITIONAL ESTIMATES HEARING : 08 February 2016

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(AE16/110) - Provisions of equipment - departmental - Internal Product (DIBP)

Senator Ludwig, Joe (L&CA) asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. Has electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive, video cameras) been provided by the department/agency to departmental staff? If yes provide a list of:
2. What has been provided?
3. The purchase cost.
4. The ongoing cost.
5. A list of any accessories provided for the equipment and the cost of those accessories. (e.g. iPad keyboards, laptop carry bags, additional chargers etc).
6. A breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

Answer:

1. The table below lists the type, quantity, cost, and ongoing cost of electronic equipment provided to DIBP staff since the change of Prime Minister on the 14 September 2015. Electronic Equipment is provided to portfolio staff in more than 70 locations in Australia and overseas. To provide a further breakdown of accessories, by location and classification would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.
