*Answer:*

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection has received correspondence from the Attorney-General's Department in relation to the National Firearms Agreement review as part of the Department's membership of the Firearms and Weapons Policy Working Group.

The correspondence includes draft documentation that will be subject to the deliberative processes of the Commonwealth, State and Territory governments through the Council of Australian Governments. As such, the correspondence has not been tabled.
