Question No. AE17/120

Senator Bilyk asked the following question at the hearing on 28 February 2017:

1. What was the Department's total expenditure on the following categories of ground transport in calendar year 2016 (GST inclusive):

- a) Taxi hire;
- b) Limousine hire;
- c) Private hire car; and
- d) Ridesharing services.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The total expenditure for the Attorney-General's Department (including the Australian Government Solicitor, the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse, and Royal Commission into the Protection and Detention of Children in the Northern Territory) on ground transport for the calendar year 2016 was \$1,113,735 (GST inclusive).

The department does not disaggregate expenditure of this type in its accounting system, and it would require an unreasonable diversion of resources to provide the requested information in relation to each category of ground transport.
