Senator Carr, Kim (L&CA) written:

Does the Department provide uniforms to Australian Border Force staff and can you provide pictures of the uniform and outline material it was made from? Are there different uniforms for different staff, please provide pictures.

Answer:

The Department provides uniforms to officers undertaking border force officer duties. The ABF has six types of uniform:

- **General Duties Uniform** – Worn by most officers who operate in the land environment. Shirts are manufactured from polyester cotton. Pants are made from 3XDry® material.
- **Polo uniform** – Worn by officers in warmer tropical climates as a heat mitigation strategy.
- **SES Office uniform** – Worn by SES in the office environment as a general duties uniform.
- **Ceremonial uniform** - Worn by SES and Superintendents on occasions where ceremonial uniform is required.
- **Specialist General Duties Uniform** - Worn by officers working in the marine environment. Made of 100% cotton and vented material to mitigate and reduce heat loading.
- **Specialist Boarding Uniform** – Worn by Marine crew under operational equipment (boarding vests). The uniform is manufactured using a modacrylic blend that reduces heat loading and provides protection against fire.
