**ADDITIONAL ESTIMATES HEARING : 27 February 2017**

**(AE17/178) - MIRPC - Number of people determined to be refugees - Programme 1.5: IMA Offshore Management**

Senator Carr, Kim (L&CA) written:

Since last Estimates, How many people have been determined to be refugees?

- Where have they been resettled?
- Where are they living now?
- Have they taken PNG visas and are they living in the community?

*Answer:*

Between 17 October 2016 and 27 February 2017, there were 43 transferees who were determined to be refugees following a positive Minister's Final Determination.

As at 27 February 2017, of the 43 refugees:

- One refugee had settled in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea.
- 38 refugees were accommodated in Manus RPC.
- Three refugees were accommodated in East Lorengau RTC, and
- One refugee was in Australia for medical treatment.
