Offshore Management**

Senator Carr, Kim (L&CA) written:

Since last Estimates, how many have been determined not to be refugees?

- Where are they living now?
- Have any voluntarily returned home?
- Have any involuntary returns been attempted by the Nauruan authorities?

Answer:

As at 27 February 2017 in Nauru, no transferee has been determined not to be a refugee. All transferees still have avenues within the refugee status determination process; as such none are classified as failed asylum seekers. No asylum seekers voluntarily returned home.
