(AE17/193) - NRPC - Determined to be refugees - Programme 1.5: IMA Offshore Management

Senator Carr, Kim (L&CA) written:

How many have been determined to be refugees?

- Where are they living now?

- Have they taken visas and are they living in the community?

Answer:

As at 27 February 2017, the number of transferees determined to be refugees by the Government of Nauru was 1,014¹.

Of these:

- 206 were living at the Regional Processing Centre,
- 737 were living in the Nauruan community,
- 71 are no longer on Nauru.

Note¹: Figure excludes 30 babies born to refugee parents.
