How many asylum seekers have been transferred to Australia for medical assistance since the last Estimates?

- How many were children?
- How many of these medical transfers were for instances of self-harm?
- How many of these medical transfers were for instances of alleged sexual assault?

Answer:

Between 17 October 2016 and 27 February 2017, there have been two asylum seekers transferred to Australia for medical assistance.

Of these, there were no children.

Of these, there were no instances of self-harm.

Of these, there were no instances of alleged sexual assault.
