Senator Carr, Kim (L&CA) written:

Has the Department engaged in discussions with other countries, regarding Australian immigration processes and have any countries toured Australia, Manus and Nauru facilities to understand how they work?

Answer:

DIBP routinely engages with international counterparts to provide advice and background on Australia's immigration systems. International delegations regularly tour DIBP facilities in Australia.

Tours of facilities in Papua New Guinea and Nauru are the responsibility of those governments.
