Senator SINGH asked the following question at the hearing on 26-29 May 2014:

Senator SINGH: Can I turn to the terms of reference. Have any stakeholders asked to be completely exempt from this PPS regime?

Mr Walter: In the context of the review?

Senator SINGH: Yes.

Mr Walter: Unfortunately, that would be a question I would really have to check with the reviewer on. We do have an independent reviewer. He is doing that. I know his consultation with stakeholders has only just begun. I think it is probably too early to say. It may be one that you want to come back to next time, Senator.

Senator SINGH: Okay.

Mr Walter: He has only just started those consultations. There is a call for submissions and there has only been a small number, I understand.

Senator SINGH: The AFSA does not have anything to do with the review?

Mr Walter: Of course, they have been consulted. The reviewer has already met with them. The department provides the secretariat support and all of those sorts of things.

Senator SINGH: Will there be public submissions made available, like on the Attorney-General's Department website?

Mr Walter: I will just have to check. The reviewer has called for submissions. I will just have to check the terms in which he has called for them, whether he has agreed that they will be public or not public. I think he has probably given people the option of making confidential submissions to him. I will check that for you and give you an answer on notice, if that is okay.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

No stakeholders asked to be completely exempt from the PPS regime in the context of the review.
