List the participants in the meeting, the topic of the discussion, who arranged or requested the meeting, the location of the meeting

**The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:**

1. The Attorney-General's Department and agencies within the Attorney-General's portfolio are required to comply all relevant Codes of Conduct and, as far as the Attorney-General is aware, have done so.
2. The Attorney-General, Minister for Justice and staff within their offices are compliant with all relevant Codes of Conduct.
