Senator Singh, Lisa (L&CA 90) asked:

Senator SINGH: Okay. But you are not aware of any undeclared secondary employment. Because, if there had been, I was going to ask how many had been disciplined for failing to declare.

Mr Pezzullo: I will need to take on notice whether there is any current disciplinary action afoot. I would not necessarily see—in fact I almost certainly would not see—most of it unless it requires my attention. I am not aware of any officer having being disciplined for failing to declare.

Answer:

No sanction under section 15 of the Public Service Act 1999 has been imposed on a Customs Official for failing to apply for approval before engaging in outside employment or voluntary activities.
