Of the \$569 million in savings, how much of that is expected to come from the Department of Immigration and Border Protection?

a. Outline the impact of these savings on the Department

Answer:

Of the \$569 million in savings, \$39.6 million is expected to come from the department over four years. The department will manage the impact of these savings within its allocated appropriation, particularly through reviewing expenditure in the targeted areas of advertising, consultancy and travel costs, and through deregulation efficiencies.
