What do 'on water operations' entail?

Answer:

On-water operations, as previously noted in question on notice SE13/0256, are defined as:

- any operational activity relating to the Maritime domain.
- This relates to air and water activities concerning the transit and operational outcome of those attempting to reach Australia, which may include; but is not limited to:
 - o on-water response;
 - o detection;
 - o interception;
 - o boarding;
 - o transfer of vessel and/or people;
 - o search and rescue activities;
 - o surveillance;
 - o intelligence; and
 - o surface and aerial asset disposition, procedures, activities and the decision making in relation to any of the above.
