(BE14/277) PROGRAMME – 3.3 and 3.4: Illegal Maritime Arrival (IMA) Onshore Management

Senator Carr (Written) asked:

How much will it cost to extend the leases at Blaydin and Wickham Point facilities? a. Why are these facilities being upgraded?

b. How much are the upgrades costing?

c. Are detainees from other facilities which are earmarked for closure going to be transferred to these facilities?

d. When are such transfers expected to occur?

e. What are the capacities for each facility?

Answer:

a. The Department of Immigration and Border Protection is currently negotiating the terms of lease extensions for the Bladin and Wickham Point facilities.

b. The Department is currently scoping potential upgrades and does not have a cost at this time.

c. Transfers within the immigration detention network occur on a regular basis. Should there be an operational requirement to transfer detainees to the Bladin or Wickham Point facilities then this will be done as part of regular transfer operations.

d. Transfers of detainees are routine and ongoing depending on operational requirements.
