Senator Conroy (Written) asked:

In paragraph 140, the protocol for appointment of Custom's officials to become part of Border Protection Command is detailed QUOTE "When control of an ACBPS asset is transferred from one authority to another the CHOP (Change of Operational control Procedure) reaffirms any operational limitations on the asset and any potential limitations that may be identified in the future."

Can you inform the committee if the "Change of Operational control Procedure" highlighted any shortcomings with the navigational skills – specifically in relation to the location of Indonesian territorial waters?

Answer:
