BUDGET ESTIMATES – 26 – 27 MAY 2014

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(BE14/568) PROGRAMME – Internal Product

Senator Lundy (Written) asked:

For all employees who were redeployed please provide:

- a. Their age.
- b. Their gender.
- c. A description of their position before and after redeployment.
- d. The APS classification level of their position before and after redeployment.
- e. Their wage before and after redeployment.
- f. Contract type (non-ongoing versus ongoing) before and after redeployment.
- g. Where they were located before and after redeployment.
- h. Please provide the reason for the redeployment.
- i. Please specify any other costs incurred by the department/agency because of this redeployment.
- j. Please provide all relevant dates.

Answer:

Of the eight employees who were redeployed (noting one redeployee is still awaiting placement) within the portfolio from 7 September 2014 to 31 May 2014:

- (a) The age of redeployees ranged from 26 to 60 years of age.
- (b) Four redeployees are male and four are females.
- (c) Roles before redeployment include project management, operations support and integrity officers. Roles after redeployment include ICT enterprise architecture, records management, operations support, integrity officers and investigations officers.
- (d) Two Executive Level positions, six APS level positions.
- (e) All wages before and after redeployment were comparable, the wage range of redeployees is from \$57,462 to \$143,093.
- (f) All positions before and after redeployment are ongoing.
- (g) All positions before and after redeployment are located in the Australian Capital Territory.
- (h) Reasons for redeployment include work area restructure, and relocation of positions interstate.
- (i) Nil.
- (j) Further dates cannot be provided due to privacy limitations.
