1. What is the progress of this review?
2. How many submissions have been received? From whom?
3. What proportion are supportive of change to the existing arrangements?
4. Will they be made available on the Department's website?
5. When can we expect a report, or Government decisions arising from the review?

**The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:**

1. The Government is considering the views of all stakeholders.
2. Thirty eight submissions were received by the due date of 23 February 2015. The names of respondents are not being made public.
3. The views expressed in submissions are confidential.
4. Submissions will not be made public.
5. Any amendment to the migration regulations will be undertaken by the Department of Immigration and Border Protection in 2015-16.
