Senator KIM CARR: I would like to know how many people in this country might be affected by the minister's proposals to change the Citizenship Act?

Senator KIM CARR: If you have got a person of interest—however that is defined—how will you know, if you remove their citizenship, their Australian citizenship, whether or not they would be stateless?

Senator KIM CARR: How many Australians would be affected by this proposal, and how will you know, if a person's citizenship is to be removed, that they will not be rendered stateless?

Senator Cash: I will take that question on notice.
