# (BE17/120) - Legacy caseload - total number of IMAs who have received assistance under PAIS since commencement - Programme 2.4: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator McKim, Nick (L&CA 78) asked:

Senator McKIM: Could you provide the total number of IMAs who have received assistance under PAIS since commencement, if possible broken down into nationality and as a percentage of the legacy caseload.

Ms Lauman: I think we took that on notice slightly earlier in the day. We had a figure and the people yet to lodge.

Senator McKIM: Okay. I have possibly asked the same question in a different way there, so I accept that. If I did ask a slightly different question, I would just ask you to take them both on notice.

#### Answer:

As at 24 May 2017 date 3,224 illegal maritime arrivals (IMAs) have received assistance under the under the Primary Application and Information Service (PAIS). This excludes:

- People who after being offered assistance, departed Australia, declined assistance or otherwise disengaged and those who have died.
- IMA's referred for PAIS assistance who are yet to indicate they wish to take up that offer.
