Please provide details of any discussions with the Minister or other Departments regarding possible resettlement countries for refugees in RPCs and the status of those negotiations

Answer:

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection works closely with the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade to assist the Governments of Nauru and Papua New Guinea (PNG) to find appropriate resettlement options for people found to be refugees. The Department also engages with the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet and other agencies on this issue as appropriate. The Department provides regular updates to the Minister for Immigration and Border Protection on regional processing matters, including third country resettlement.

It is not appropriate to disclose details of discussions on third country resettlement as it would disclose information captured by the public interest immunity claim made by the Minister for Immigration and Border Protection on 7 January 2017.
