Senator Carr (Written) asked:

Christmas Island

- a. Who currently holds the tender for Christmas Island?
- b. When does it expire?
- c. What plans are in place to deal with the expiration?
- d. Will it be released on AusTender?

Answer:

- a. As at 27 November 2017, Serco Australia Pty Ltd has the current contract for immigration detention services and International Health and Medical Services has the current contract for detention health services.
- b. These contracts are due to expire on 10 December 2014.
- c. Request for Tender 04/14 for the provision of onshore immigration detention services at all mainland immigration detention facilities, including Christmas Island, was released on AusTender on 3 April 2014. The department anticipates executing new contracts through finalising this process by 10 December 2014 to align with current contract expiry.
