What programs will be delivered and what qualifications will graduates receive from the Australian Boarder Force College?

Answer:

As the establishment of Australian Border Force College is in the early design phase the full list of the type of programs and qualifications is yet to be determined. The programs and qualifications will need to be aligned to the Department's, and the Australian Border Force's, workforce model and skill requirements.

A focus of the Australian Border Force College is to raise, train and sustain the officers within the Australian Border Force, and therefore some of the key programs aligned to this will be:

- Border Force Officer Recruit Training
- Investigations training
- Use of Force and Operational Capability Training
- Detector Dog Handler Training
- Marine training

As part of the broader Department some programs that will be delivered under the auspices of the College will be:

- Management and Leadership development;
- Graduate programs;
- Induction for new employees

The Department will also partner with external providers to provide recognised vocational and tertiary training for key programs.
