SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 20 October 2014

Senator Carr, Kim (Written) asked:

"How many claims for returns of seized goods in accordance of section 205B of the customs act 1901 have been made over the past 12 months? Please provide details of any claims including the dates the claims were made, descriptions of the items claimed and the value of the individual claims.

a. How many infringement notices have been issued by the ACBPS over the past 12 months. Provide an offences breakdown of the numbers of infringement notices issued."

Answer:

Between 21 October 2013 and 20 October 2014 there were:

- 1,110 claims for return of seized goods made in accordance with section 205B of the *Customs Act 1901* (Cth). The attached document shows the date each claim was received and a description of the seized goods. The value of the seized goods is not recorded in the system used to record the claims received.
- A total of 573 infringement Notices issued. The table below provides a breakdown of this figure by the type of offence.
