How does the Government plan to retrieve the orange lifeboats from Indonesia?

- a. Under which budgetary heading do the cost of these lifeboats fall under?
- b. Are they included in Australia's defence expenditure?
- c. Are they included in Australia's DIBP expenditure?

Answer:

To date, the Government has not sought the return of any lifeboats.

a-c. The funding for the lifeboats was included as one of a range of measures in the 2013-14 Mid-year Economic and Fiscal Outlook under the heading: *Operation Sovereign Borders – strengthening response capability for illegal maritime arrivals*.

Expenditure for lifeboats is the responsibility of the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service.
