Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- a. How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
- i. Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
- ii. Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
- b. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

The portfolio expended a total of \$6,059.50 (GST inclusive) for the period 1 June – 31 October 2104. Expenditure was for the purchase of general office supplies. Any further disaggregation of cost would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.
