SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES – 20 OCTOBER 2014

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(SE14/466) PROGRAMME – 2.1: and 2.2: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Hanson-Young (Written) asked:

- How many people detained at the Manus Island camp have received final refugee status determinations? How many negative, how many positive?
- How many people detained at the Nauru detention camp have received final refugee status determinations? How many negative, how many positive?

Answer:

As at 27 November 2014:

- 10 transferees in Papua New Guinea had received their final refugee determination, all positive; and
- 308 transferees in Nauru had received their final refugee status determination, 299 positive and nine negative.
