Mr Manthorpe: That one, we would have to take on notice— Senator KIM CARR: Since November 2014, how many of these people have actually been obliged to leave the country? Mr Pezzullo: I think we will wrap that into a general omnibus response."

Answer:

From 1 November 2014 to 30 September 2015, 146 New Zealand nationals have been removed.
