Senator Hanson-Young, Sarah (L&CA 114) asked:

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Can you tell me how many of those actual and threatened self-harm incidents on Nauru included children? Ms Briscoe: I do not have the breakdown. I would have to take that on notice

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Could you take that on notice?

Ms Briscoe: Certainly.

Answer:

Transferees

Between 1 January and 31 August 2015, six of the 74 'actual' and none of the 23 'threatened' self-harm incidents by Transferees at the Nauru Regional Processing Centre involved a minor.

Refugees

Between 1 January and 31 August 2015, there has been one 'actual' self-harm incident and three 'threatened' self-harm incidents involving Refugee minors in Nauru.
