Senator Ludwig, Joe (L&CA) written:

Are there any provisions to over-rule a Head of Agency's decision to hire a non-Australian citizen? If yes:

- 1. Who can over-rule this decision?
- 2. Under what circumstances can it be over-ruled?
- 3. How many times has this occurred since the Federal election in September, 2013

Answer:

Yes

- 1. The Federal Court or Federal Circuit Court of Australia through the Administrative Decisions, (Judicial Review) Act 1977 is able to 'set aside' a decision by an Agency Head made under section 22 (8) of the Public Service Act 1999.
- 2. The Administrative Decisions, (Judicial Review) Act 1977 outlines the grounds on which a person may apply to the Federal Court or Federal Circuit Court for review.
- 3. We are not aware of any requests for review of decisions under s22(8) being lodged.
