Senator Griff, Stirling (L&CA 91) asked:

Senator GRIFF: So 5,045 of 12,000 are effectively to be resettled. How many of those are women and children? Mr Manthorpe: Mr Mansfield or I may have that material. Mr Mansfield: Otherwise we will have to take it on notice. Mr Manthorpe: Yes, we may have to take it on notice.

Answer:

At 30 September 2016, of the 5045 Syrian and Iraqi Humanitarian Programme entrants that formed part of the additional 12,000 places 1630 were women and 1952 were children.
