How many separations occurred in the 2015-16 financial year, by:

- a) Classification;
- b) State or territory;
- c) Ongoing staff;
- d) Non-ongoing staff; and
- e) Reason for separation.

Answer:

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection recorded 1270 separations for the 2015–16 Financial Year.

- a) A breakdown of the 1270 separations by classification is provided in the table below.
