**Senator Siewert** asked:

In terms of the number of people on voluntary income management in Western Australian and the Northern Territory, how many people have come off after three months?

**Answer:**

Between 24 November 2008 and 30 November 2012, 3,077 Voluntary Income Management (VIM) agreements have ceased in the Northern Territory and Western Australia. On all of these occasions, people had been on for at least three months

Across Australia, a total of 5,502 were on VIM as at 30 November 2012.
