Senator SIEWERT: I specifically want to know: is this money coming out of the NHT fund? And I am sure Mr Thompson and Mr Sullivan know why I am asking that question.

Senator Cormann: I think that question was actually answered.

Senator SIEWERT: Okay. Was the NHT ministerial board consulted over that decision? Mr Sullivan: I would have to check the records in terms of the meetings of the ministerial board that have taken place since the election. I am happy to take that on notice.

Answer:

The redirection of funds from an appropriation to the Natural Heritage Trust to another purpose is not a decision for the Natural Heritage Ministerial Board but a matter for government. The Board only makes decisions on funding within the Natural Heritage Trust. It is a matter for government to determine the level of appropriation to the Trust.
