Senator Urquhart asked:

Senator URQUHART: Can you tell me the total area that has been affected by bushfires so far this season?

Dr Vertessy: I do not know the answer to that.

Dr Canterford: We would have to take that on notice. We would have to check with our fire agencies.

Senator URQUHART: Sure. But you can provide that if you take it on notice?

Dr Canterford: My colleague has just suggested that they may have information on their website, but I can source that for you if you like.

Senator URQUHART: That would be great.

Dr Vertessy: It is not something that we would normally track and report on, but we are happy to look it up for you

Answer:

The Bureau of Meteorology (the Bureau) does not maintain data on the extent of bushfires. Data on areas burnt by bushfires is collected by state agencies in each jurisdiction. The Bureau has compiled the list below based on information published on various state agency websites showing areas burnt for the larger fires during the 2013-14 southern fire season.
