Senator Macdonald:

In answer to written questions regarding a 15.07 per cent reduction in staff at the Department, it has been indicated that the indicative salary savings per annum of the reduction is \$2,078,120.90. The total cost of the redundancies was \$2,278,717.00.

The answer provided also indicated that 58 of the effected employees were re-distributed into different positions in the department, and that another 14 found work in other APS positions.

- Q1. How many staff in total is represented by the 15.07% figure?
- Q2. What is the annual cost of salaries and disbursements for the 58 personnel who were redistributed within the department?

Answer:

While the department is able to provide information in regards to employees who received a voluntary redundancy payment, details of the calculations relating to other employees were not transferred from the Department of Climate Change and Energy Efficiency following the machinery of government change.
