**Senator CARR asked:** —With regard to the December 2006 report by the House of Representatives Standing Committee on Employment, Workplace Relations and Workforce Participation, entitled *Shifting Gears: employment in the automotive components manufacturing industry*, is the department able to indicate when there will be a response to that report?

Mr P Clarke—A response is being developed. I cannot give you a date as to when it will come out.
