Tourism Australia undertakes two activities which are cost recovered. These are Tourism Australia managed trade event and the provision of tourism statistics and analysis from Tourism Research Australia. In accordance with Australian Government policy, a Cost Recovery Impact Statement is currently being finalised in consultation with the Department of Finance on these two activities.
