Senator Sherry asked:

What is the approximate expenditure on e-tax each year by the ATO?

Mr Konza—We would have to take that on notice. Are you talking about the complete running costs, development costs and marketing?

Senator SHERRY—Yes. You would probably need to separate them.

CHAIR—You mean the processing costs?

Senator SHERRY—Yes. The marketing, the establishment costs and the ongoing running costs.

Mr D'Ascenzo—We can provide that.

Answer

The table below provides a breakdown of the e-tax marketing, establishment and ongoing running costs for the 2004-05 and 2005-06 income years and an estimate for the 2006-07 income year.

Establishment and ongoing running costs are incurred to enhance the features of the e-tax software and to update it for legislative change.

The table also provides the number of taxpayers that lodged their income tax returns using e-tax for the 2004-05 and 2005-06 income years and an estimate for the 2006-07 income year.
