Senator EGGLESTON asked:

- 1. How many people currently work for the ABS?
- 2. How many people worked for the ABS in each of the last two years?
- 3. What is the current ABS budget and each of the two preceding financial years of 07/08 and 08/09?
- 4. Has the ABS had to cut any staff, projects, programs or reduce the amount of statistical information it provides over the last two years due to budget cuts.
- 5. (If so) What has been the reduction in staffing levels?
- 6. What projects, programs or information have been ended or cut back.

Answer:

- 1. As at 31 January 2010, there are 3,030 people currently working for the ABS. This is on a headcount basis.
- 2. In the last two financial years, the staffing numbers as at 30 June (headcount) were:

2008-09: 2,740 2007-08: 2,873

3. The current and two preceding financial year appropriation budgets for the ABS are:

2009-10: \$327.9m Budgeted Departmental Expense Appropriation
 2008-09: \$282.6m Actual Departmental Expense Appropriation
 2007-08: \$302.3m Actual Departmental Expense Appropriation

4. The ABS budget situation for 2008-09 and beyond involved insufficient funds to sustain continuation of the ABS's current work program. As a result the ABS reduced its work program in 2008-09 to stay within its budget allocation. Savings were identified across the organisation in both statistical and administrative areas. As a result of increased funding from the Government in the 2009 Budget, and after an extensive consultation process with users, the ABS reinstated or expanded the 2009-10 statistical and analytical work program for most of the work programs that were affected by cuts made in 2008-09.

- 5. In 2008-09, staffing levels were managed by redeployment, natural attrition and a temporary recruitment freeze to reduced staffing levels by approximately 180 people. However, as a result of increased funding from the Government in the 2009 Budget, the ABS reinstated or expanded the 2009-10 statistical and analytical work program for most of the work programs that were affected by cuts made in 2008-09 and staffing levels have since increased.
- 6. As a result of increased funding from the Government in the 2009 Budget, and after an extensive consultation process with users, the ABS reinstated or expanded the 2009-10 statistical and analytical work program for most of the work programs that were affected by cuts made in 2008-09. The table below summarises the changes that were made to the 2008-09 and 2009-10 work program.
