Senator RYAN: Do we have the criteria for the decision on Ford?
Senator Carr: I beg your pardon?
Senator RYAN: We have made one decision. I appreciate the details are in negotiation, but one decision has been made. You and cabinet have made a decision with respect to Ford.
There were criteria for that. Can we have the criteria for that decision?
Senator Carr: I will have to take on notice the method by which information can be provided. We just want to have a look at it in terms of negotiations that are currently underway regarding the contract.

ANSWER

The Ford grant was assessed against key criteria including at a broad level: will it (the proposal) improve the competitiveness of the industry; will it provide broader economic benefits; and will it improve the environmental performance of the industry.
