**QUESTION No.:** AI-198

Please provide the number of research-only staff, teaching only-staff, staff with combined teaching and research responsibilities, and administrative staff at Australian universities, including an indication of whether those positions are full-time, part-time and/or casual positions – how each of these categories of employment have changed in each year since 2005?

#### **ANSWER**

The Higher Education Staff Data Collection provides information on various characteristics of staff employed by Table A providers (public universities) and Table B providers (Bond University, The University of Notre Dame Australia and Melbourne College of Divinity) and Avondale College, a total of 42 major providers. Private providers are currently not required to report staff data. Data for Full-Time and Fractional Full-Time (also referred to as Part Time) staff comprise actual numbers of staff (head count) and full-time equivalence (FTE). Casual Staff data are only reported on FTE basis and not as a count of individuals.

The latest available data on higher education staff numbers are for 2011. The number of staff (excludes casual) employed at Australian universities increased by 21.1 per cent for the period 2005 to 2010 and the number of staff FTE (includes casual) increased by 18 per cent between 2005 and 2010.

Casual staff FTE as a proportion of all staff FTE increased from 14.4 per cent in 2005 to 16.2 per cent in 2010.
