QUESTION No.: AI-181

- 1. Has the funding under this program now been fully allocated?
- 2. What amount remains unallocated and when do you anticipate decisions will be made regarding the uncommitted funding and what is the anticipated timeframe for announcement of further allocations?
- 3. How will further allocations be determined? Is a further tender round planned; will fresh publicly advertised expressions of interest be sought; are direct approaches to service providers proposed or will decisions be based on the submissions provided prior to the middle of last year? What will be the process?
- 4. Will you provide a breakdown of the tender process outcome to date listing the organisations that applied for funding, those that received funding, the geographic area intended to be serviced by the successful and unsuccessful applicants and the electorates in which each applicant was based?
- 5. Is it intended to follow through on assurances provided to indigenous chamber of commerce in future funding allocations and if so what is proposed?
- 6. Will further SBAS funding allocations focus on particular segments of the small business community or under-serviced locations? If so, what and where?

ANSWER

- 1. No. The program is now funded on an ongoing basis.
- 2. Following the 2012 round, 2012-13 and 2013-14 funding is essentially committed as projects are funded for up to two years.
- 3. SBAS is a competitive, merit based funding program. The next round is expected to be called toward the end of 2013-14. This will be announced through a public call for applications. The Minister for Small Business, subject to available funding, may call for applications for funding through a round or consider ad hoc proposals for National Interest projects under the SBAS program at any time.
 - 4. A list of organisations that received funding through the 2012 round, the geographic area serviced and the electorate of the location of the applicant is at **Attachment A**.

Details of unsuccessful applications cannot be made available as unsuccessful applicants have not consented to the release of such information.

- 5. The Australian Indigenous Chamber of Commerce was not an applicant for the 2012 round.
- 6. Rounds under the SBAS program may be themed at the discretion of the Minister and may be targeted toward a particular small business opportunity and or challenge and or may include a business service(s) as specified by the Government. Any theme would be announced at the time of calling a round and details included in the SBAS Customer Guidelines for that round.
