ANSWER

1. The Language, Literacy and Numeracy Program (LLNP) under improved access has the following target commencements:

Commencements previously funded	17,585	17,849	18,116	18,000	71,550
Additional commencement target under improved access	3,415	5,151	8,884	12,000	29,950
Total commencements funded	21,000	23,000*	27,000	30,000	101,500

*Revised from 23,500 to 23,000 in 2012-13 Financial Year as a result of a reduction in funding of \$4million

In 2011-12 LLNP exceeded the commencement target of 21,000 by 122 commencements (total 21,122).

LLNP is on track to meet the annual target of 23,000 commencements for the 2012-13 financial year with 15,016 commencements from 1 July 2012 to 28 February 2013.
