Senator RHIANNON: What is your involvement with the Future Fellowships program? **Ms Baly:** The Future Fellowships program is a program of the Australian Research Council. **Senator RHIANNON:** I understand that it has been wound up.

Ms Baly: It is a terminating program, as I understand it. I think Professor Byrne might have answered some questions on that this morning. It is a terminating program from, I think, the middle of this year.

Ms Kelly: But the government has made no decision one way or the other on the future of that program at the moment.

Senator RHIANNON: Has the department recommended that the program should continue? Ms Kelly: I do not think I can comment on the advice that the department might give to the minister about budget issues.

Senator RHIANNON: Do you judge that it is a useful program?

Ms Kelly: Yes, it has been a useful program, particularly in attracting high-quality Australians back to Australia to take up research appointments.

Senator RHIANNON: Do you expect that this trend of attracting high-quality researchers back to Australia will continue?

Ms Kelly: We certainly hope so. I think the additional investment in research over recent years has meant that there are more opportunities for high-quality researchers. The Future Fellowships program clearly helps that process, but I think it is not the only thing that attracts them.

Senator RHIANNON: Has any quantitative or qualitative work been done to judge how this trend can be maintained after the Future Fellowships program?

Ms Baly: I understand an evaluation of that program is due this year.

Senator RHIANNON: When will that be released and will it be released publicly?

Ms Baly: I cannot give you the exact timing of that. The ARC would know the answers to those questions.

Senator RHIANNON: Could that be taken a notice.

Ms Baly: We can take that on notice on behalf of the ARC, certainly.
