#### Senator Carr asked about:

Could you provide details of the consultations you have held with industry on the United States – Australia free trade agreement?

#### **ANSWER**

The Department of Industry, Tourism and Resources (DITR) was an activite participant in the Government's extensive consultations with State and Territory Governments, industry bodies and other stakeholders in developing its approach to the AUSFTA negotiations. As a part of this process, DITR seconded an officer at the Executive Level 1 position to the negotiating team within the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT).

Members of the AUSFTA negotiating team discussed the AUSFTA with over 500 peak industry and business groups, companies, professional associations and unions, and non-governmental organisations during the course of the negotiations. DITR was represented at many of these discussions either through its seconded officer or more directly by officials from DITR's Trade and International Branch and/or officials from specialist industry divisions within DITR (for example, the TCF Policy Unit).

The AUSFTA was an item for discussion at policy advisory bodies including the Trade Policy Advisory Council, of which the Secretary of DITR is a member, and the Automotive Council. The negotiating team held a number of consultations at important stages of the negotiations with manufacturing industry, service industry and peak business bodies.

DITR also organised an industry roundtable on AUSFTA attended by peak industry groups and chaired by Minister Hockey on 18 June 2003. A list of those who attended the roundtable is at <u>Attachment 1</u>.

There was also close consultation with key industry groups likely to be affected by the agreement during the final stage of negotiations. The automotive and textiles and fashion industries were consulted in the final stages as industries likely to be most directly affected by tariff reductions and rules of origin. DITR was also represented by officials at all relevant negotiations both in Australia and the United States.

Attachment 2 provides a full list of organisations consulted before and during the negotiations; a list of meetings and events such as public meetings and briefings or seminars for larger groups of companies; and a list of organisations contributing written submissions to the Government that agreed to have their names published.
