ANSWER

Department of Industry, Tourism and Resources

The efficiency dividend is a mechanism through which the Australian Government demonstrates and achieves a share of productivity gains through the more efficient delivery of services by agencies. The efficiency dividend is applied only to Departmental appropriations.

The Department allocates resources in accordance with priorities as set by the Government.

The Department seeks continuous improvement and DITR and its employees agree to work together to pursue the following strategies as outlined in DITR's Corporate Plan:

- People Investment Strategy recruiting, developing and retaining people with the skills we need; 1.
- Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Strategy making the best use of 2. technology to deliver efficient and effective services;
- Financial Strategy making the best use of the money available to us; and 3.
- Performance Management Strategy ensuring that we are on track to fulfil our Mission. 4.
