## Senator Campbell asked about:

What are the likely employment impacts of the establishment of the small-scale mammalian cell production facility?

## **ANSWER**

The scoping work commissioned by the Department estimates that around 50 additional direct jobs would be created initially with the establishment of a greenfield facility in the order of 500 to 1000 litres capacity. However, decisions on the scope of the facility and whether it would be a greenfield or brownfield facility would be left to applicants to determine in their consideration of what would be commercially feasible.
