Isn't this announcement contradictory to what was said at Budget Estimates, what is ANSTO's policy & procedures on media announcements in relation to commercial in confidence matters?

(Context to Question)

During my questioning to departmental officials on Monday 31 May 2010, Dr Paterson quoted commercial in confidence matters:

Senator HEFFERNAN—So, at the present time with the investment, how many customers is PETNET shipping to now? I believe you are going to Royal North Shore Hospital. Is there anyone else?

Dr Paterson—I believe that we should be cautious about raising particular customer names as they may be commercial-in-confidence matters.

The following announcement appeared on **PETNet's website in March of this year**... referencing commercial-in-confidence is a good way to avoid the answer but there is not much confidentiality when ANSTO put out a press release. By the way, Siemens cyclotrons @ ANSTO.....Siemens cameras and RNS.....more than a coincidence.
