Senator HEFFERNAN—.... I have questions on the national medical cyclotron, but I will go to the OPAL reactor. Can you confirm that the original budget for the reactor was \$300 million? **Mr McIntosh**—In 1997 dollars it was \$286.4 million.

Senator HEFFERNAN—Near enough. What is the cost, including rectification, to this point? **Mr McIntosh**—There was some additional money granted in the budget in 2002 or 2003 for security costs consequent upon September 11. That \$286.4 million was also inflated over the years and the cost of the reactor has been within that inflated—

Senator HEFFERNAN—So how much is it? Is it \$400 million?

Mr McIntosh—In current dollars? We will have to take that on notice.
